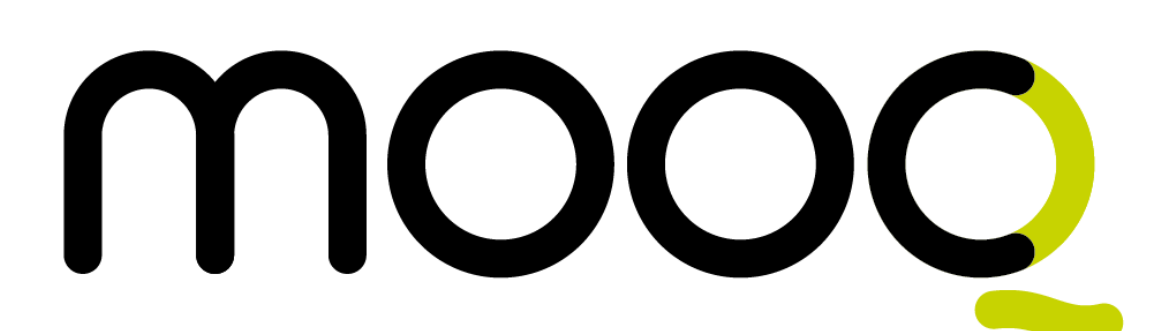
Massive Open Online Courses and Online Collaboration

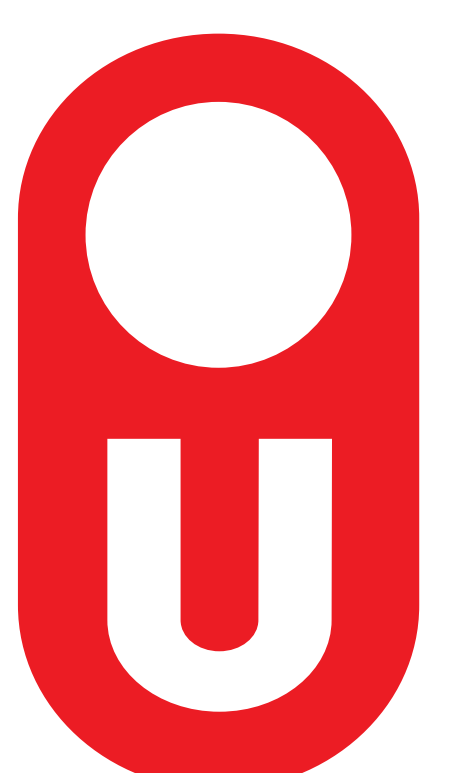
